COOKIES

1. WHAT COOKIES ARE AND WHAT COOKIES DURALAMP USES

Cookies are packets of information sent by a web server (e.g. the site) to the user's Internet browser, which is automatically stored by the latter on the computer and automatically sent back to the server each time the site is accessed. By default, almost all web browsers are set to automatically accept cookies. The website does not use cookies for the transmission of personal information.

DURALAMP uses only technical cookies. The use of technical cookies is strictly limited to the transmission of session identifiers necessary to allow the safe and efficient exploration of the site. The technical cookies used on this site avoid the use of other computer techniques that could potentially compromise the confidentiality of users' navigation and do not allow the acquisition of personal identification data of the user.

2. INFORMATION ON COOKIES ISSUED BY DURALAMP

We provide the following information about the cookies used on the Site:

- 1) The **domain name** from which the Site server transmits cookies is: www.duralamp.com.
- 2) **Purpose of collection:** cookies are used to allow easier and faster navigation within the Site or to carry out statistical and anonymous analysis/checks on the use of the site (technical cookies).
- 3) **Data collection:** the following information is stored: the addresses in URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) notation of the resources requested, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the user's operating system and computer environment.



From a technical point of view, cookies (transmitted by the domain www.duralamp.com) contain the following information: a numeric ID that uniquely identifies DURALAMP and a numeric ID that identifies the user (who navigates within the Site), both stored within our database; a numeric ID that uniquely identifies the user's navigation (so-called "record") within our database; an alphanumeric pseudo-random session ID automatically deleted by the browser when it is closed (session cookie).

1) **Cookies validity:** the Site uses session cookies (see par.1), which are deleted when the browser is closed.

2) **Need for acceptance of cookies:** acceptance of cookies is not compulsory but their deactivation, although it allows navigation within the Site, may not make it possible to release some of the Site's contents and functions.

3) **Data Communication:** the information collected through cookies is confidential and is not communicated to third parties.

3. THIRD PARTY COOKIES

The Site uses so-called "third party cookies", i.e. cookies that are issued and managed by parties other than Dura Lamp S.r.l., for purposes specific to such parties.

In order to allow you to make a free and informed choice, we provide you with the following information regarding the type and identification of cookies, the characteristics and purposes of cookies, as well as the link to the detailed information regarding these cookies:

4. DEACTIVATION AND DELETION OF COOKIES

You can deactivate/activate or delete cookies at any time by using your web browser settings. In particular, if you do not wish to receive cookies, you can set your browser to warn you of the presence of a cookie and decide whether or not to accept it; you can also automatically refuse all cookies by activating the appropriate option in your browser. You can also delete specific cookies that have already been stored in your browser, or block the storage of cookies on your computer by specific websites, or block third-party cookies.

Each browser has its own type of cookie management, in the administration or preferences panel you can change/manage the parameters and delete them.

To disable the use of all or only some cookies, it is necessary to modify the settings of your browsing browser (Firefox, Chrome, Explorer, Safari, Opera, etc.).
